

31 Ways to Praiseⁱ—

Here is a wonderful way to start each day in praise to God. It will open the door for your praises to flow freely from your heart and lips during prayer and throughout the day. Focus on one attribute of your awesome God and Father each day, using the following Scripture-based sentences as “praise starters.” At the end of each month, start the list over, combining traits when the month is shorter than 31 days. We have placed this all on one page so you can pull it out and use it more easily if you want to.

- 1. God the Creator:** Creator God, I praise You because You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to everything and the multitudes of heaven worship You (Nehemiah 9:6).
- 2. The Only God:** God, I praise You because You are the Lord, and there is no God besides You (Isaiah 45:5).
- 3. The Almighty God:** O Lord, God Almighty, who is like You? You are mighty, O Lord, and Your faithfulness surrounds You (Psalms 89:8).
- 4. The Everlasting Father, the Ancient of Days:** I praise You, Lord, as the Ancient of Days (Daniel 7:9), the Everlasting Father (Isaiah 9:6), who lives forever and ever.
- 5. Loving God:** I praise You God, because You are loving, whose very nature is love (1 John 4:16).
- 6. God of Justice:** Lord, I praise and magnify You, who are just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus (Romans 3:26).
- 7. Faithful God:** Heavenly Father, I give You praise and adoration, because You are Faithful, keeping Your covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love You and keep Your commands (Deuteronomy 7:9).
- 8. Merciful God:** You are gracious and merciful God (Nehemiah 9:31), and I praise You for Your great mercy.
- 9. God my Refuge and my Fortress:** I praise You Lord, for You are my mighty Rock, my Refuge (Psalms 62:7).
- 10. Patient, Persevering God:** Father, I praise You because You are patient with Your children, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9b) and I thank You for Your patience with me.
- 11. Eternal, Saving Father:** I give praise to You, Father, the only God our Savior. To You be glory, majesty, dominion and power, through Jesus Christ our Lord before all ages now and forevermore (Jude 25).
- 12. The Holy One:** Holy, holy, holy are You Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come (Revelation 4:8).
- 13. Personal God:** I praise You, God, because You are a personal God, who gives me the honor of knowing You personally, even inviting me to feast at Your table in the kingdom with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Matthew 8:11).
- 14. Giving God:** All praise and honor be Yours, O God, because You are a generous God, who did not even stop short of giving Your Son (John 3:16).
- 15. God My Provider:** I praise You today, Lord, as Jehovah-Jireh, my Provider, who makes all grace abound to me and generously provides all I need and more, so I may give to others (2 Corinthians 9:8).

16. God My Shepherd: I bless Your name and praise You as Jehovah-Raah, The Lord My Shepherd, who will shepherd me and guide me in the paths of righteousness for Your name's sake (Psalms 23:1-3).

17. God My Banner: Praise to You, my God because You are Jehovah-Nissi, The Lord My Banner, God my victory, who always causes me to triumph in Christ (2 Corinthians 2:14).

18. God My Peace: I praise You with all my heart, Lord, because You are Jehovah-Shalom, The Lord my Peace, the God of peace who will soon crush satan under my feet (Romans 16:20).

19. The God My Healer: Father, I praise You because You are Jehovah-Rapha, the Lord my Healer (Exodus 15:26) and it was by Your stripes that I was healed (1 Peter 2:24).

20. The God of all Comfort: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort (2 Corinthians 1:3).

21. The God of Miracles: Lord, I praise You because You are the God who performs miracles: You display Your power among the peoples (Psalms 77:14).

22. A Forgiving God: I want to bless You with praise, Father, because You are a forgiving God, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love (Nehemiah 9:17).

23. The Burden Bearer: Praise be to the Lord, to God my Savior, who daily bears my burdens (Psalms 68:19).

24. The Faithful God: I praise You because Your love, O Lord reaches to the heavens, Your faithfulness to the skies (Psalms 36:5), and great is Your faithfulness (Lamentations 3:23).

25. King of kings and Lord of lords: All honor and praise be to You, my God, the blessed and only Sovereign Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords (1 Timothy 6:15).

26. God My Deliverer: I will Praise You because You are my Help and my Deliverer, O Lord (Psalms 70:5).

27. The Lifter of My Head: Father God, I praise You because You are a shield around me, O Lord; You bestow glory on me and lift up my head when I am weary or worn down (Psalms 3:3).

28. God of Light: I praise You, Lord because You are my Light and my Salvation (Psalms 27:1), and because You know what lies in darkness, and light dwells with You (Daniel 2:22).

29. God of Joy: I give You praise, O Lord, because You have granted me eternal blessings and made me glad with the joy of Your presence (Psalms 21:6).

30. God Who Answers Prayer: I praise and honor You, Father, because You are a God who loves to answer prayer and who begins to answer even before I pray (Isaiah 65:24).

31. God of All the Earth: I praise and adore You, Lord, as the Holy One of Israel, my Redeemer, the God of all the earth (Isaiah 54:5)
